



03 Jun Feudo Zirtari Rosso Sicilia 2012

Deep ruby color; red fruits, some spice on the nose; black cherry, black plum, redcurrant, licorice on the palate.

Full body, rustic, reserved tannin, some acidity, some blackcurrant bite on the finish. Benefits with exposure to air/decanting. Blend of 55% nero d'avola and 45% syrah; made in Sicily.

This is fairly obscure, Sicilian winemaker. No website. No winery photos or owner backstories found online. Nice, big body, stand-upto-grilled-red-meats pour. I can give you website of the American importer, which is worth visiting and has some details about this interesting, good-value wine. \$10-13

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
