Kettmeir Pinot Bianco 2014



Alto Adige, Italy, \$20

Bracingly acidic, with flavors of quince and peach, this beauty calls out for a seafood salad and other light fare. It's perfect for a Saturday lunch on the patio. Kettmeir also makes a delicious pinot grigio and Muller-Thürgau. ABV: 13 percent.
